

## ITLOS Case No. 21; Advisory Opinion On Illegal Fishing Activities

Dear Mr. Gautier

Switzerland would like to take the opportunity to respond to your request for an advisory opinion as submitted by the Sub-Regional Fisheries Commission (SRFC).

Although Switzerland has neither a coast line nor are there any fishing vessels flying the flag of Switzerland, we would like to issue a clear statement regarding illegal fishing activities within maritime areas under the jurisdiction of Member States. As a member of UNLOS we feel obliged to answer the questions contained in the order concerning Case No. 21, issued on May 24, 2013.

- The Flag State is obliged to combat IUU-Fishing activities of its vessels as the exploitation of resources in the EEZ is reserved for the coastal state.
- 2. The Flag State should be fully liable for such illegal activities.
- If the domestic legislation of the coastal state is part of the agreement or at least known to the Flag State, the respective State or agency should be held liable.
- The pertinent provisions of UNCLOS constitute a sufficient legal basis for a sustainable management.
