MR DOO-YOUNG KIM RE-ELECTED DEPUTY REGISTRAR OF THE TRIBUNAL

On 21 March 2012, the Judges of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea re-elected Mr Doo-young Kim, of Korean nationality, Deputy Registrar of the Tribunal.

Mr Kim, who was elected to this post in June 2002 and re-elected in 2007, had previously been Director of the International Legal Affairs Division of the Treaties Bureau in the Korean Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (1999-2001) and Lecturer in Law of the Sea at Korea University, Seoul (2001-2002). In accordance with the Rules of the Tribunal, Mr Kim has been re-elected for a term of five years.
