SOLEMN DECLARATION BY JUDGE AD HOC

PUBLIC SITTING TO BE HELD ON MONDAY, 4 NOVEMBER

The Tribunal will hold a short public sitting in *The "Arctic Sunrise" Case (Kingdom of the Netherlands v. Russian Federation)* on Monday, 4 November 2013 at 3.00 p.m.

During the sitting, Mr David Anderson, Judge *ad hoc* chosen by the Kingdom of the Netherlands will make the solemn declaration required under article 9 of the Rules of the Tribunal.

The sitting will be held in the main courtroom of the Tribunal and is open to the public.
