TRIBUNAL TO DELIVER ITS JUDGMENT ON 14 APRIL 2014 AT 2 P.M.

The International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea will deliver its Judgment in *The M/V "Virginia G" Case (Panama/Guinea-Bissau)* on Monday 14 April 2014 at 2 p.m. The Judgment will be read by the President of the Tribunal, Judge Shunji Yanai, at a public sitting in the courtroom.
