The Government agrees to provide, within the court facilities referred to in (a) to (e) above, all necessary utilities and services including telephone, facsimile, data communication and internet services, electricity, water and gas, as well as air-conditioning, as necessary, pursuant to article 5, paragraph 4, of the Agreement.

The description of the abovementioned facilities may be amended upon mutual agreement between the Government and the Tribunal.
