# THE M/V "NORSTAR" CASE (PANAMA V. ITALY)

# TRIBUNAL TO DELIVER ITS JUDGMENT ON PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS ON FRIDAY, 4 NOVEMBER 2016 AT 3 P.M.

The International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea will deliver its Judgment on the preliminary objections raised by Italy in *The M/V* "*Norstar*" (Panama *v*. Italy) case on Friday, 4 November 2016 at 3 p.m. The Judgment will be read by Judge Vladimir Golitsyn, President of the Tribunal.

The public hearing on Italy's preliminary objections to the jurisdiction of the Tribunal and the admissibility of Panama's application were held from 20 to 22 September 2016.
