THE M/T "SAN PADRE PIO" CASE (SWITZERLAND V. NIGERIA), PROVISIONAL MEASURES

SOLEMN DECLARATION BY JUDGES *AD HOC* AT 3 P.M. ON 20 JUNE 2019

The Tribunal will hold a public sitting in the M/T "San Padre Pio" Case (Switzerland v. Nigeria), Provisional Measures on Thursday, 20 June 2019 at 3 p.m., during which the judges ad hoc chosen by Switzerland and Nigeria will make the solemn declaration required under article 9 of the Rules of the Tribunal. Switzerland has nominated Ms Anna Petrig to serve as judge ad hoc and Mr Sean David Murphy has been nominated by Nigeria.

The hearing in *The M/T "San Padre Pio" Case (Switzerland* v. *Nigeria), Provisional Measures* will take place on 21 and 22 June 2019. The schedule of the hearing is now available on the website of the Tribunal.
