TRIBUNAL TO DELIVER ITS ORDER AT 12 NOON ON 6 JULY 2019

The International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea will deliver its Order in *the M/T "San Padre Pio" Case (Switzerland v. Nigeria), Provisional Measures,* at 12 noon on Saturday, 6 July 2019. Judge Jin-Hyun Paik, President of the Tribunal, will read the Order.
