DISPUTE CONCERNING DELIMITATION OF THE MARITIME BOUNDARY BETWEEN MAURITIUS AND MALDIVES IN THE INDIAN OCEAN (MAURITIUS/MALDIVES)

SPECIAL CHAMBER TO DELIVER ITS JUDGMENT AT 11 A.M. ON FRIDAY, 28 APRIL 2023

The Special Chamber formed to deal with the *Dispute concerning delimitation of the maritime boundary between Mauritius and Maldives in the Indian Ocean (Mauritius/Maldives)* will deliver its Judgment at 11 a.m. on Friday, 28 April. The Judgment will be read out by Judge Paik, President of the Special Chamber.

The Judgment will be read at a public sitting of the Special Chamber.
